Summer Sea Kayak Adventures



High Energy and High Adventure Awaits You at the Coastal Empire Council! Take advantage of our great Team Building Program. This is a High Adventure Program requiring participants to be 13 on or before September. Participants will undergo a two-day Orientation to develop their Kayaking, Navigational, Wilderness Survival and LEAVE NO TRACE camping techniques for this awesome thrill packed Marshland and Sea

Adventure! Upon arrival, groups will undergo a Medical History re-check (Class 3) and BSA Swim Test followed by an introduction into Sea Kayaking, Open Water Rescue and then learn new skills for high tech camping and cooking. Check-in time for your scheduled week will begin at 1:00 PM on Sunday. Groups will depart from the training area to set sail to one of many of our outpost campsites along the watery trail on Tuesday morning. Depending upon tides, the possibilities would be Creighton Island, Cabbage Island, and Sapelo Island. While on your adventure, your group will travel through some of the most beautiful and pristine southeastern marshlands exploring areas of the Georgia Coastline. Studies in Marsh Ecology, Conservation and Oceanography will be part of the adventure as well as visiting many historical locations! While on this great adventure, participants



will have opportunities for swimming, fishing, crabbing, and shrimp net casting. Group size limited to fourteen participants. Individual Scouts, Explorers, Venture Crew Members, or Varsity Team members may register. Adult Leaders are welcome to join in on the fun for the same cost! Two qualified Adult Staff members holding (ACA) Kayaking and/or BSA Lifeguard certifications will conduct all programs.

Fees include all food, camping equipment and Sea Kayak equipment Rentals and Recognition items. **FEES ARE TRANSFERABLE TO ANOTHER SCOUT BUT NOT REFUNDABLE.** Positively **NO** refunds will be made at camp. A \$25 processing fee will be retained in the event of any refund.
